Gibson Steps
Best visited before 9am and the 2 hours before sunset. Check tide and swell conditions. When busy, park and walk on trail from 12 Apostles.



12 Apostles
Get out early to find your own space and catch a sunrise to remember. Return in time for sunset and stay to view the little penguins below.

Loch Ard Gorge
Enjoy 6km of trails and clifftop lookouts branching from 3 car parks. Best enjoyed before 9am and in the 2 hours before sunset.




London Bridge
Famously collapsed in January 1990. 3 viewing areas on 3 levels. Views well all day. Stay after sunset to view a small colony of little penguins.

The Grotto
Better after 11am as the sun gains elevation. Enjoy limestone framed views from boardwalk or take steps down to a walled viewing area.




Bay of Islands
