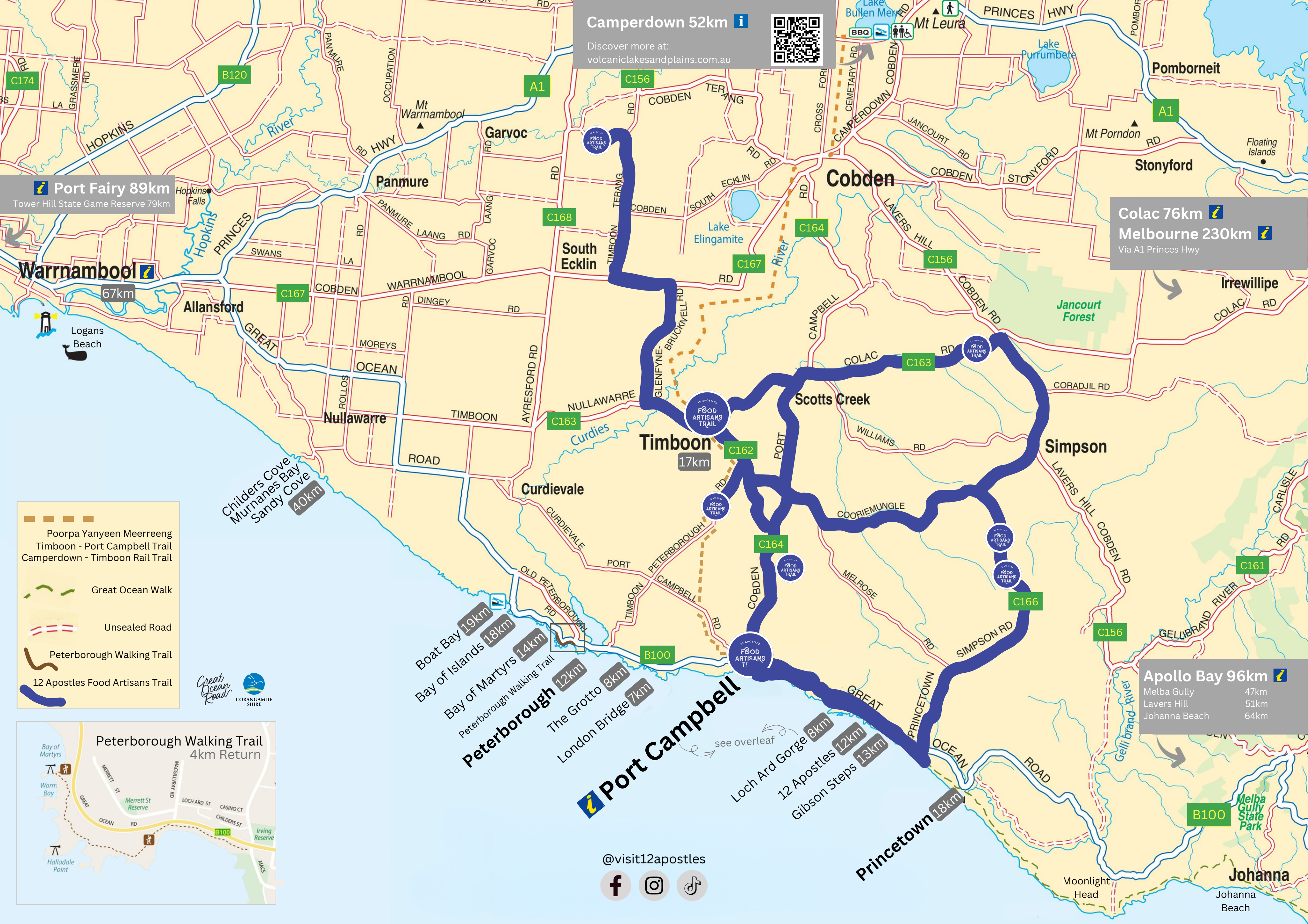

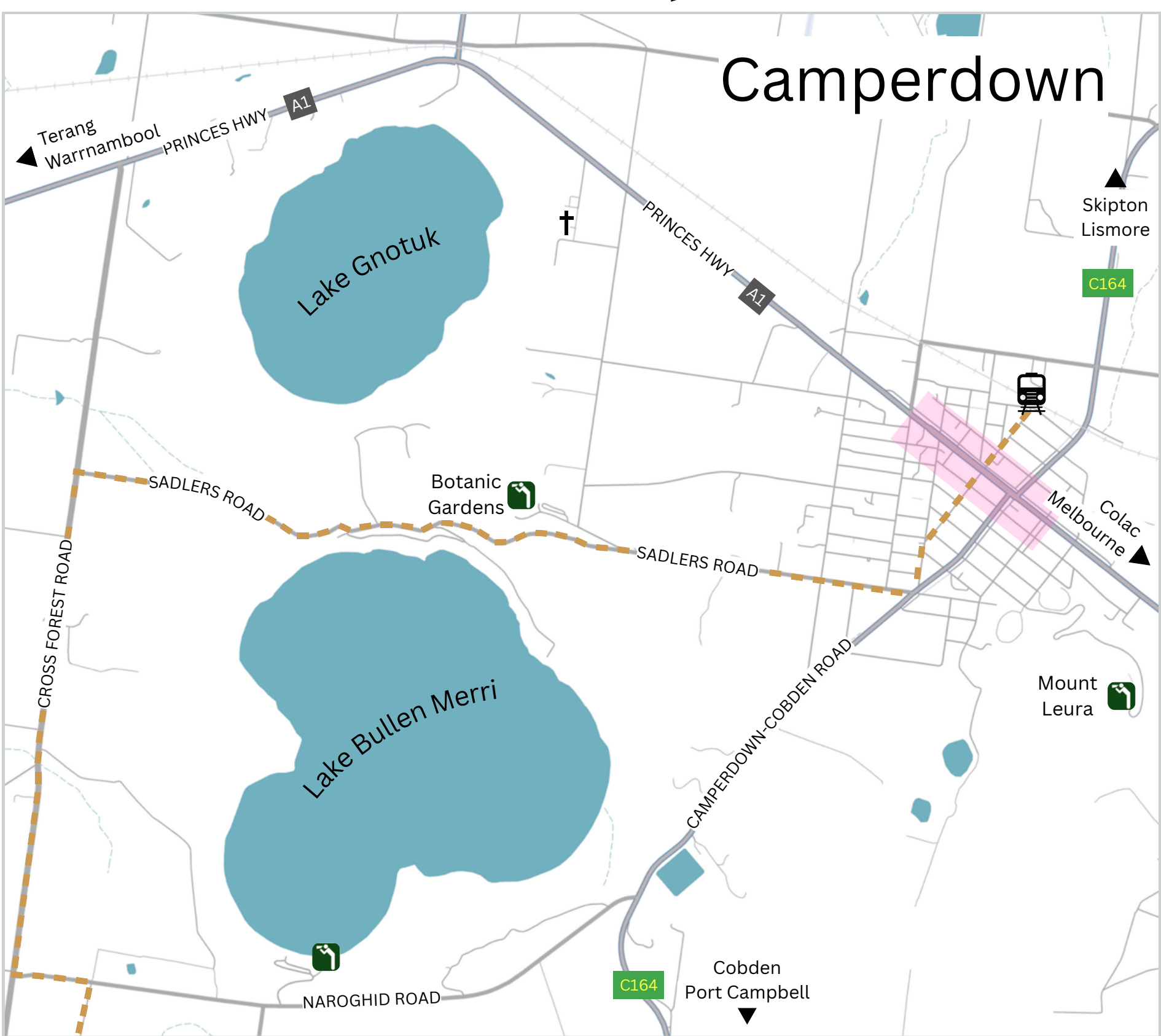

Loch Ard Gorge is named after the infamous shipwreck of the Loch Ard, which occurred in 1878 just offshore of Mutton Bird Island. Of the 54 passengers and crew aboard, only two teenagers, Eva Carmichael and Tom Pearce, survived, making their way to safety through the gorge's waters.
